Commenter suggests changing the word "of" to "that" in 777:10-3-3(b)(4) so that the line reads "In the event of that a change in contact information occurs during the application process, the Board shall provide the Secretary of the Board with updated contact information." Commenter suggests deleting the "of" that falls between the words "date" and "the notice" in 777:10-3-3(f)(2)(B) so that the sentence reads "which shall be held no earlier than forty-five (45) calendar days from the date of the notice of intent to terminate is mailed to the charter school; and"	The agency has implemented the proposed change.
Commenter suggests changing the reference in 777:10-3-3(f)(3) from (2)(D) to (2)(C).	The agency has implemented the proposed change.
