Major Changes from Last Year

NFAY

- Definition has changed from "within the first 10 days" to "Oct.
 1"
- Status will be calculated by SDE and available for verification during the post-code correction window

Second Time Tests

- SDE will automatically mark any ones that we can identify
- You will still need to mark some (e.g., transfers, any we could not match to previous records)

Major Changes from Last Year

- No More OMAAPs
 - Students who took OMAAP in 2013 will not be included in Student Growth
 - No more 2% OMAAP cap

 Social Studies and 8th Grade History will return to the Performance Component.

Major Changes from Last Year

- 8th Grade EOIs
 - Middle school students enrolled in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II will take the proper EOI but not the Math OCCT.
 - Middle school students in high school History, English, or Biology will still have to take both the EOI and OCCT.
- How does this affect the growth component?
 - For reading, we will still use OCCT to OCCT (current grade to previous)
 - For math, we will pair the Algebra I EOI to the previous year's grade level OCCT.

Additional Changes

- Districts will not receive bonus points
- Ties for the bottom 25% will be broken by including students who qualify over students who do not.
- The year-to-year growth bonus point will be calculated.
