

ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Scoring Appeal Request Information 2016-2017

Scoring Appeals are most often requested by the state education agency (SEA), local education agency (LEA), or school. DRC has established a Scoring Appeal Process that should be utilized when there is a concern that a student's test may have been scored incorrectly.

Scoring Appeals are only for students' responses on the Writing and Speaking tests and are not applicable to multiple choice items. Therefore, only grades 1-12 Speaking (Online) and Writing (Online and Paper) tests will be available for rescoring. Kindergarten and Alternate tests are entirely multiple-choice and are therefore not applicable to the Score Appeal process.

Scoring Appeal Process

The SEA will complete and fax/mail the *Scoring Appeal Request Form* to DRC.

If the student's score <u>does</u> change, a new State Student Response File, District Student Response File (affected records only), and an Individual Student Report (affected students only) will be generated and posted on WIDA AMS. No other reports will be generated.

If the student's score does not change, the site will be notified and no reports or data files will be generated. A \$200 fee per domain will be incurred by the LEA and/or SEA.

DRC will have two Scoring Appeal processing windows:

- The first window will be for all Scoring Appeals received at DRC by July 14. If the Scoring Appeal results in a better score, the posting of the online reports will be August 30.
- The second window will be for all Scoring Appeals received at DRC by September 22. If the Score Appeal results in a better score, the posting of the online reports will be October 30.
