# Reporting Requirements

**The State Department of Education shall report the following annually (O.S. §,1210.701):**

- ❑ The number of students taking an advanced placement exam and the number of exams taken;
- ❑ The number of exams that receive a score of three or better;
- ❑ The number of school sites offering advanced placement courses and the number of school sites with students taking an advanced placement exam;
- ❑ The number of school sites which have received funding and the amount of awards, by type of award;
- ❑ The number of students who receive assistance with the test fee and the average amount of assistance; and
- ❑ An evaluation of the cost versus the benefits of this program.

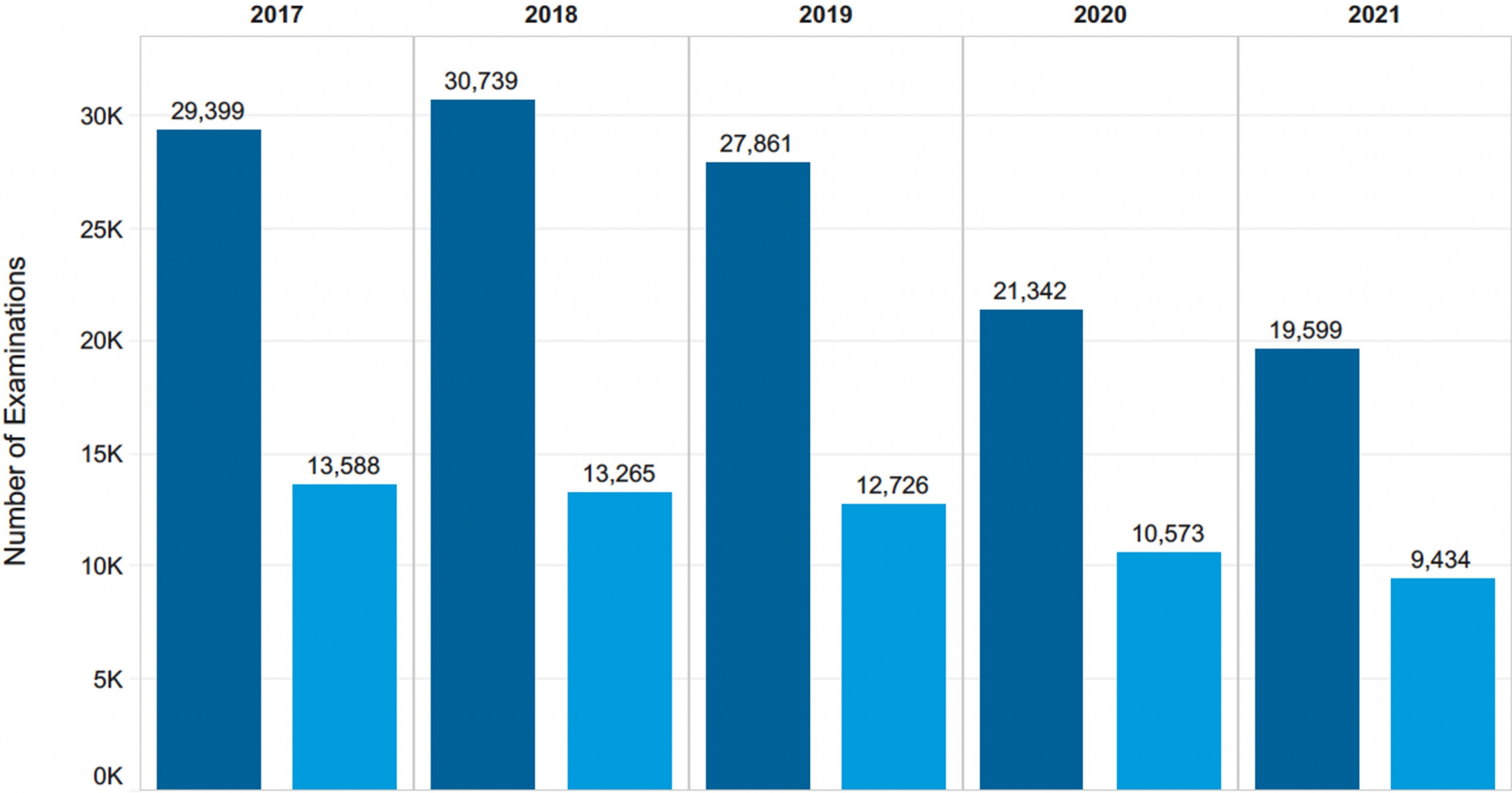

# Advanced Placement Summer Workshops

Each year, the Oklahoma State Department of Education offers week-long summer workshops for teachers of Advanced Placement courses. The workshops provide guidance and resources for effective instructional practices to support students in being successful in Advanced Placement courses and on Advanced Placement exams. The workshops are facilitated by Northeastern State University and the University of Oklahoma.

# Cost Versus Benefits

Oklahoma, public high school students earned **9,434** qualifying AP® scores of 3, 4, or 5 in 2021.

- These scores translate into **28,302** potential college credits.
- At a cost of **\$307.67** per college credit, the potential tuition and fee savings to Oklahoma students and families is **\$8,707,676**.
