# STATE AID FORMULA FOR OKLAHOMA SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS

# First Year WADM

#### Title 70 § 3-142 Paragraph B:

1. The weighted average daily membership for the first year of operation of a charter school shall be determined initially by multiplying the actual enrollment of students as of August 1 by 1.333. The charter school shall receive revenue equal to that which would be generated by the estimated weighted average daily membership calculated pursuant to this paragraph. At midyear, the allocation for the charter school shall be adjusted using the first quarter weighted average daily membership for the charter school calculated pursuant to subsection A of this section.

# First Year WADM

#### Title 70 § 3-142 Paragraph B:

2. For the purpose of calculating weighted average daily membership pursuant to Section 18-201.1 of this title and State Aid pursuant to Section 18-200.1 of this title, the weighted average daily membership for the first year of operation and each year thereafter of a full-time virtual charter school shall be determined by multiplying the actual enrollment of students as of August 1 by 1.333. The full-time virtual charter school shall receive revenue equal to that which would be generated by the estimated weighted average daily membership calculated pursuant to this paragraph. At midyear, the allocation for the fulltime virtual charter school shall be adjusted using the first quarter weighted average daily membership for the virtual charter school calculated pursuant to subsection A of this section.

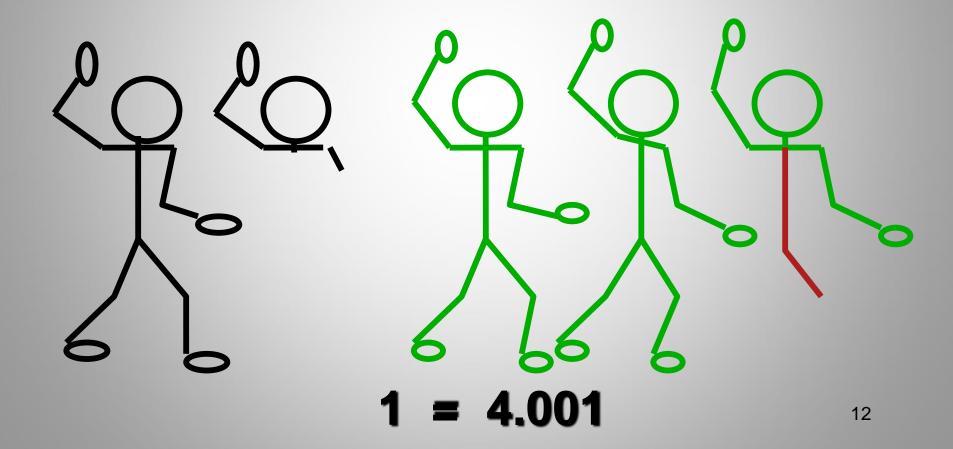

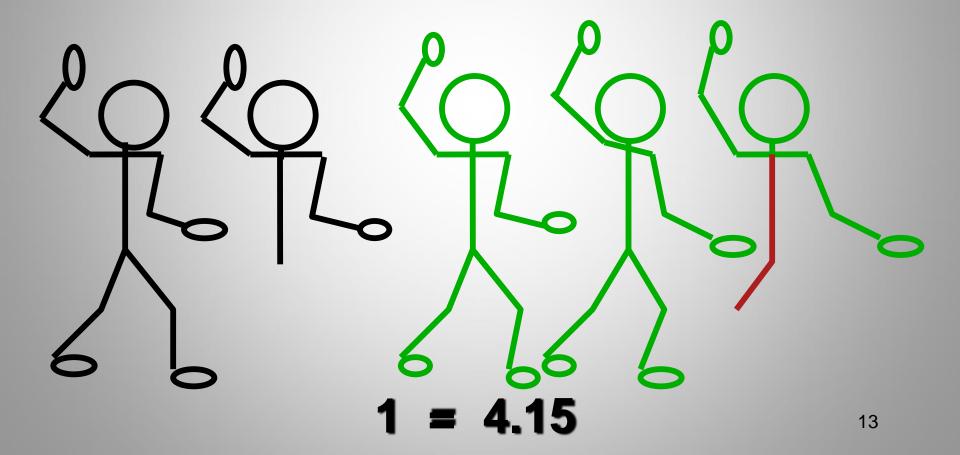

- By August 31: Notify schools of their "Initial" Tentative Allocation (Based on Aug. 1 Enrollment).
- By January 15: Notify schools of their new "Final" Tentative Allocation (Based on First Nine Weeks Weighted ADM).
- Adjust. from penalties or data corrections might still change this "Final" Allocation.

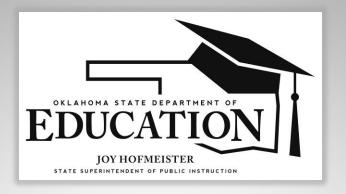
