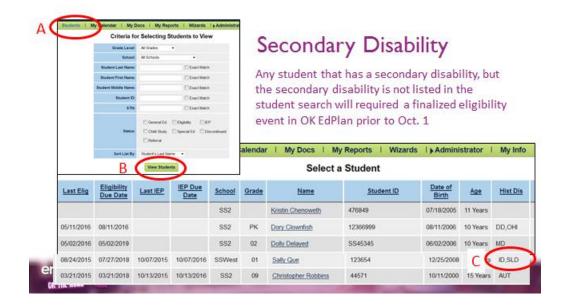
Preparation for October 1 Child Count

- All districts will use the Child Count Report to clean up the existing data in OK EdPlan for October 1st. This report will be available in OK EdPlan on September 1st. The clean up window is September 1 – September 30.
- All students <u>must</u> have a current IEP finalized in OK EdPlan, even students recently eligible during the 2016-17 school year.
- All students with a category of Developmentally Delayed in a DD district <u>must</u> have a finalized eligibility document in OK EdPlan prior to October 1.
- All students who have left the district must be exited in OK EdPlan with an appropriate exit reason by going to the student personal tab and making the student inactive.
- All students who are moving into a district <u>must</u> have a finalized IEP in the new district prior to October 1.
- All districts with students in the following enrollment status categories MUST go to each student's personal page and update the enrollment status. A finalized IEP is not required. This information is essential for an accurate LRE:
 - o Residential facility
 - o Correctional facility
 - o Homebound/Hospital
 - Private School



OK EdPlan: Child Count, WAVE, Updates **OSDE-**

• If a student should has a secondary disability, two disabilities should be listed under HistDis (see pictures below). If the expected secondary disability is not listed, the existing eligibility must be entered and finalized in OK EdPlan. Caution: NOT ALL students are expected to have a secondary disability. This only impacts students who should have a secondary disability.



WAVE and OK EdPlan

We are continuing to receive feedback from districts that they are unable to see students in OK EdPlan. This problem is the result of a combination of factors. To resolve this for your district:

1. Check with the person responsible for the SIS in your district. Make sure they are checking regularly for validation errors from the WAVE.

2. Submit a Help Desk ticket with OMES at 405-521-2444. If problems persist and a help desk ticket has been closed, please submit a second help desk ticket.

3. Some districts have not started the school year yet to release students as exiting the district. Contact the previous district to have the student inactivated.

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Items in OK EdPlan to be Released

Draft vs. Final Report

On August 25, users will have the ability to review which IEPs are in draft or final status in a report called "Draft vs. Final Report." It is not a required report, just helpful to districts who would like to access the information.

Evaluations

On September 1, users will be able to add evaluations within the evaluations tab by component area first. Current eligibility and IEPs do not have to be refinalized. All IEPs and eligibility documentation will be refinalized using the new format as the documents become due.
