- There are more than 85,000 FTEs (full-time equivalents) in Oklahoma public schools, including 42,395 teachers. More than 13,000 of the certified FTEs have $\mathbf{2 0}$ or more years' experience. More than
 7,000 have $\mathbf{2 5}$ or more years' experience.
