


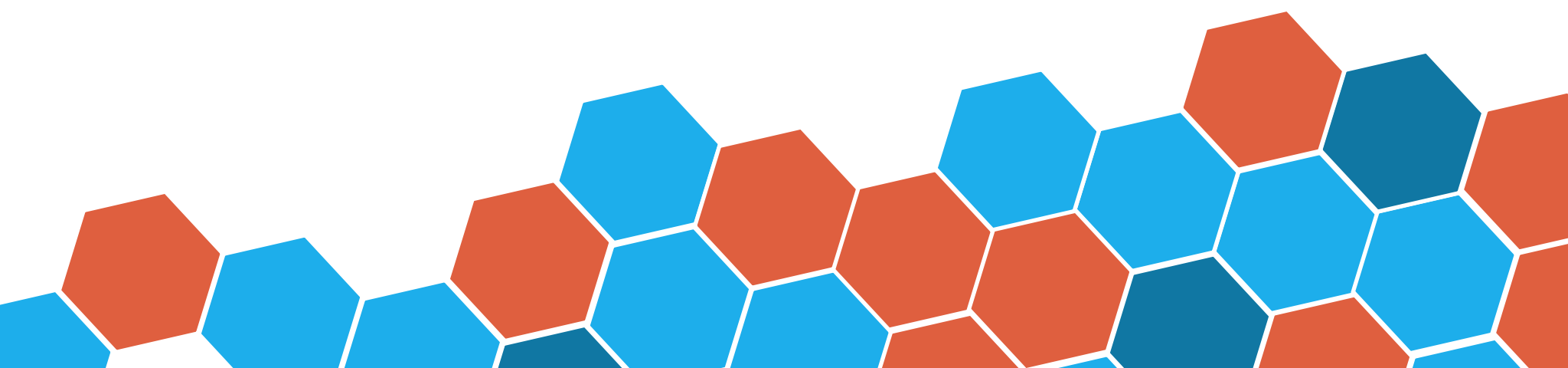
IMPLEMENTATION BRIEF

With the new Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics adopted last spring and on schedule to be assessed this school year, it has been the priority of the Oklahoma State Department of Education to ensure all teachers across Oklahoma are supported as they work to make sense of the standards and implement them with fidelity. In a matter of just a few months, we have worked to lead an aggressively-paced transition effort that has resulted in At-A-Glance documents that address critical gaps that must be taught this school year, Crosswalk documents that have been developed by the Central and Northeastern Math Consortium, blueprints, a calculator policy, and even a PD On Your Plan Short Course that introduces the new standards. Math Ready is a free course designed for high school seniors who have completed Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II, and need a transition course to get them ready for college-level coursework, thereby **avoiding remediation when entering college**. The course emphasizes understanding of mathematics concepts rather than memorizing procedures. By engaging students in real-world applications, **Math Ready** develops critical-thinking skills that students will use in college and their careers. **Math Ready** has been implemented in hundreds of high schools across the nation and has a proven track record of increasing student readiness.
