#### Federal Perspective

**Purpose:** To establish or expand COMMUNITY learning centers that provide:

- Students with <u>academic enrichment</u>, including providing tutorial service to help students (particularly students in high-poverty areas and those who attend low-performing schools) meet State and local student performance standards in core academic subjects, such as reading and math;
- Students with a <u>broad array of additional services</u>, programs and activities that are designed to reinforce and complement the regular academic program; and
  - Offer <u>families of students</u> served by community learning centers opportunities for literacy and related educational development.

- Reasonable, Necessary, Allocable and Documented
- Details, Details, Details

#### Claiming Reimbursement

- Supporting Documentation
  - Invoices must be signed and dated by Program Director
  - Services invoices must include description of services, dates of service, number of students served, fee (set fee or per student), and signed and dated by Program Director.



#### Claiming Reimbursement

- Supporting Documentation
  - Food purchases Lesson plan with academic outcome; healthy recipes
  - Travel
    - Hotel \$0 balance receipt
    - Food Itemized receipts or use per diem



#### Claiming Reimbursement

- Field Trips
  - Lesson plan with academic outcome
  - Correlates with topic of study
  - Schedule of classes for the topic
