Supt. Barnes,

In response to the observations you made during our virtual site visit, I would like to share with you the criteria that we use in determining which districts are to be monitored in any given year. As you know, all districts are monitored at least once during a three-year cycle. We also score all districts in the state using a risk assessment tool. Districts scoring ten points or more are added to the list of districts to be monitored. Districts scoring twelve points or more are site monitored. I've attached a document explaining what we assign points for, and here below I've copied the line from the tool for Western Heights.
