

2015 Graduation

- 600+ seniors
- 91% graduation rate
- = approximately 546 graduate
- In OK, about 51% go to college
- Less than 44% will graduate
- That means 122 will get a college degree

Purpose: Help students develop a self-awareness of the skill set they already possess and explore skills they will need to be successful in the workforce. Focus is on soft skills and financial literacy.


Points of Emphasis: Introduced to OK Career Guide and ICAP journey, Personality testing, personal skills, soft skills

CAREER : GRADE 8


□ Purpose: Continue building ICAP portfolio
