OAAP Update: February 24, 2020

The Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP)

The Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP) is a component of the Oklahoma School Testing Program (OSTP) and is designed for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities *and* adaptive behavior deficits; typically, these students represent no more than 1% of a district's total testing population. The OAAP utilizes Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) to measure students' academic content knowledge.

Optional DLM Instructionally Embedded (IE) Assessments

The Instruction and Assessment Planner found in Kite Educator Portal is a useful resource for ensuring students' curriculum is tied to grade level Essential Elements. OAAP students utilizing Instructionally Embedded Assessments through the Instruction and Assessment Planner have more than doubled since last year. The last day to utilize IE Assessments for the current school year is February 26, 2020. Please consider using IE Assessments next year!

Test Administrator Training Protocol

Test administrators should be finished or be in the final stages of completing training courses. Courses are accessed in the Moodle training site at http://training.dynamiclearningmaps.org/. The DLM system will only assign training courses to users assigned a teacher role in Educator Portal. District administrators who would like to complete DLM training must assign themselves a teacher role. Shared accounts are not permitted.

All training must be completed prior to administering the DLM assessment.

OAAP/Kite Check

Students must meet the state established criteria outlined in the *Criteria Checklist for Assessing Students with Disabilities on Alternate Assessments* in order to participate in the OAAP. Please ensure your district's OAAP students have "participating in the OAAP" indicated on their current IEP prior to the spring testing window. If "participating in the OAAP" is *not* indicated on a student's IEP, remove the student from Kite Educator Portal or meet as an IEP team to identify the most appropriate assessment and update the current IEP, as appropriate, prior to the opening of the testing window.

- □ <u>Kite® Student Portal</u> client has been upgraded to Version 7.0. Districts <u>must</u> <u>uninstall</u> any outdated versions of Kite Student Portal from Windows and/or Mac testing devices and install version 7.0.
- ☐ All user accounts in <u>Kite Educator Portal</u> should be current. Phase out inactive users and users who are no longer associated with your district for the current school year.
- ☐ Students have been uploaded into Kite Educator Portal. Ensure student data for

 - Complete the annual security agreement in their Kite Educator Portal profile.
