Did you know? If your household income in 2020 was less than \$72,000 you can file federal and state tax returns online for *free*!

The Oklahoma Department of Libraries is partnering with the Internal Revenue Service's VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) and TCE (Tax Counseling for the Elderly) programs to provide access to a Free File service.

This IRS-approved Free File Tax Service ...

- Lets you create an account so you can track your return
- Provides easy Q&A guidance to fill out your 1040 form
- Has no age restrictions
- Provides e-file service for both federal and Oklahoma returns
- Supports Form 1040NR (Non Resident)
- Supports Earned Income Tax Credit
- Lets you view and print tax returns
