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
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
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
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


## LIVE BIRTHS BY REGION 2007 TO 2016












#### PUPIL EDUCATOR GROWTH RATES BY PRIMARY POSITION: **REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)**






## RATE OF LEAVING EDUCATORS: REGION 1 (CENTRAL) 2012-13 TO 2017-18



## RATE OF LEAVING EDUCATORS: REGION 2 (NORTHEAST) 2012-13 TO 2017-18




#### **RATE OF LEAVING EDUCATORS: REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)** 2012-13 TO 2017-18







#### **SOURCES OF EDUCATOR TURNOVER: REGION 1 (CENTRAL)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18



#### **SOURCES OF EDUCATOR TURNOVER: REGION 2 (NORTHEAST)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18




#### **SOURCES OF EDUCATOR TURNOVER: REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18




#### **SOURCES OF EDUCATOR TURNOVER: REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18






#### **TURNOVER RATES BY PRIMARY POSITION: REGION 1 (CENTRAL)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18




## TURNOVER RATES BY PRIMARY POSITION: REGION 2 (NORTHEAST) 2016-17 TO 2017-18




#### **TURNOVER RATES BY PRIMARY POSITION: REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)** 2016-17 TO 2017-18

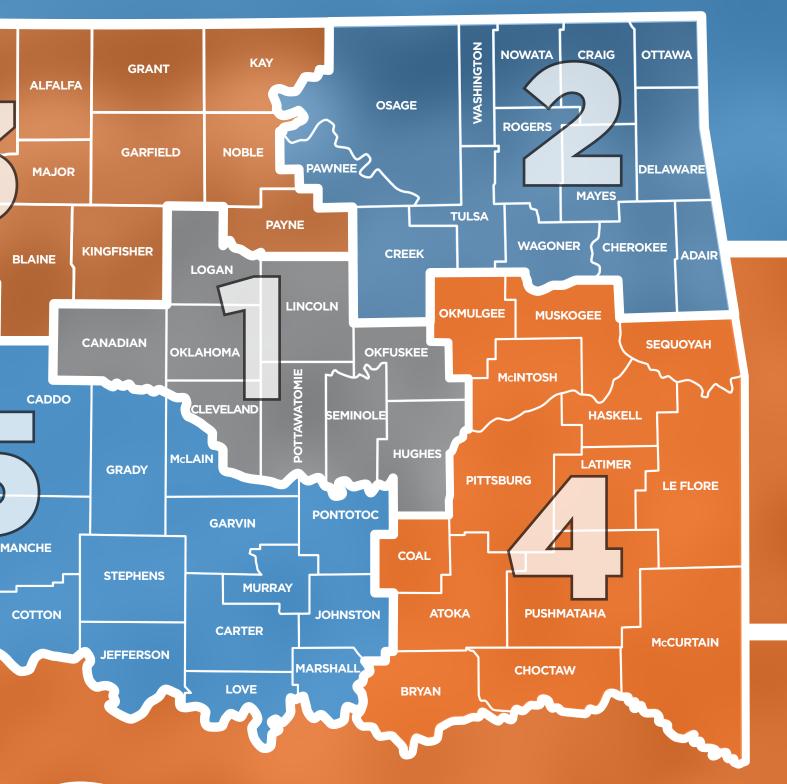



#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.1 REGION 2 (NORTHEAST)**




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.1 REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)**




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.1 REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)**



#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.1 REGION 5 (SOUTHWEST)**




### PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.2 REGION 1 (CENTRAL)



## PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.2 REGION 2 (NORTHEAST)




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.2 REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)**




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 1.2 REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)**




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.1 REGION 1 (CENTRAL)**



#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.1 REGION 2 (NORTHEAST)**




### PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.1 REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)




## PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.1 REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)




### PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.2 REGION 1 (CENTRAL)



## PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.2 REGION 2 (NORTHEAST)




#### **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.2 REGION 3 (NORTHWEST)**





## **PUBLIC EDUCATOR JOB MARKET TRENDS: SCENARIO 2.2 REGION 4 (SOUTHEAST)**

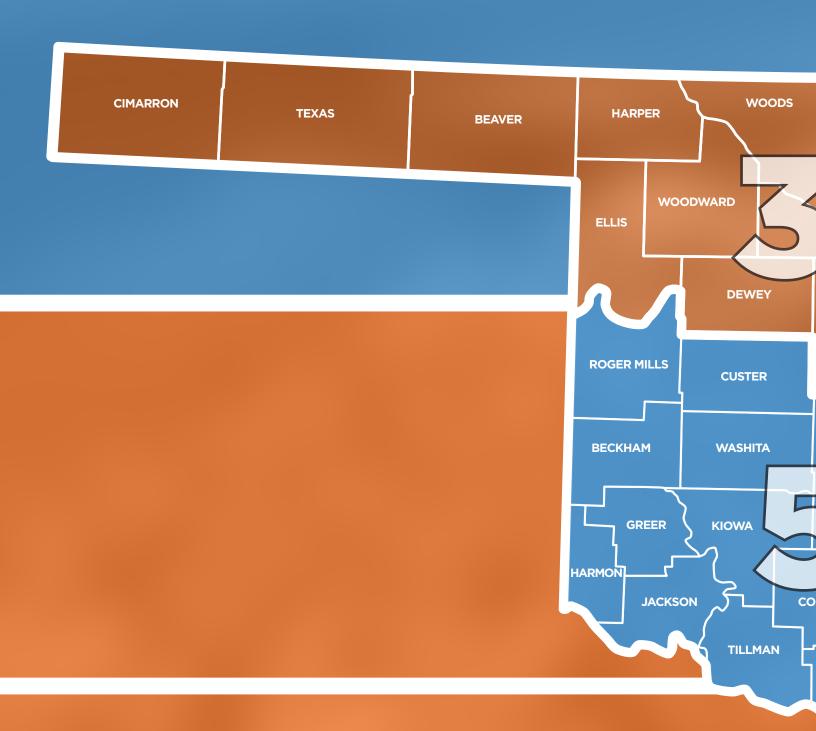


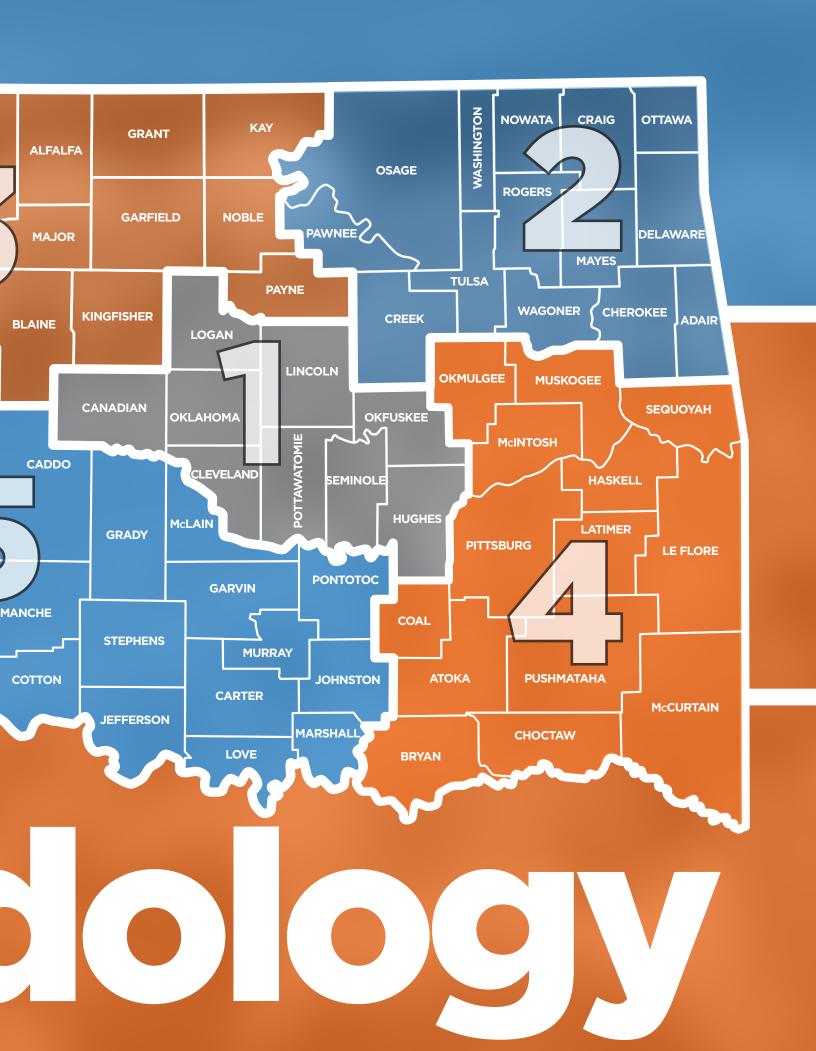
