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Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program Mapping Cut Scores from the 6-point Scale

Overview

The Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP) Portfolio assessment is designed to assess students with the most significant cognitive disabilities. The Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) has received feedback from educators regarding access limitations to required assessment items collected for the OAAP portfolio assessment.

In order to measure a broader range of student performance, the OSDE utilizes a 6-point scale. The 6-point scale incorporates a scoring rubric that captures the performance of students functioning at lowest levels of ability. This method, while providing access to students functioning at lower levels, also satisfies Federal requirements for measuring grade-level academic content standards.

Performance level descriptors were derived from the expectations for student performance and guide the establishment of cut scores. It is important to note score levels 1 and 2 are at the Unsatisfactory performance level. However, these levels do provide a measurement of growth for students functioning at lowest levels of ability.
