

Quidel QuickVue At-Home Over-the-Counter (OTC) COVID-19 Test Kits

The Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) will provide the Quidel QuickVue At-Home Over-the-Counter (OTC) COVID-19 Test kits to school districts through <u>BigCommerce</u>. This test will offer greater flexibility to schools and their families as it may be used at school as a Point-of-Care test OR at home as an Over-the-Counter test.


TESTING AT SCHOOL

o If using to test students or staff at school, the test must be used as a <u>Point-of-Care test</u> under the school district's CLIA Waiver. Follow the Instructions for Use (IFU) package insert to run the test. Test results—negative and positive—MUST be entered into the State Infection Reporting System (SIRS) in the Oklahoma State Department of Education Single Sign-On. The results are reported electronically to the Oklahoma State Department of Health from SIRS.

TESTING AT HOME

If sending home with students or staff, the test will be run as an <u>Over-the-Counter test</u>.
Follow the IFU package insert to run the test. Tests that are conducted at home DO NOT require reporting and should not be entered into SIRS.

TESTING AT SCHOOL = Report results in SIRS (positive and negative results)

TESTING AT HOME = Do not report results in SIRS

Quidel QuickVue SARS Antigen Test

- This rapid test is authorized for use at the <u>Point of Care</u>, so it must be conducted at school under the school district's CLIA Waiver using the IFU package insert.
- Test results—negative and positive—MUST be entered into the State Infection Reporting System (SIRS) in the Oklahoma State Department of Education Single Sign-On platform.
 The results are reported electronically to the Oklahoma State Department of Health from SIRS.
- This test CANNOT be sent home with students and staff.
