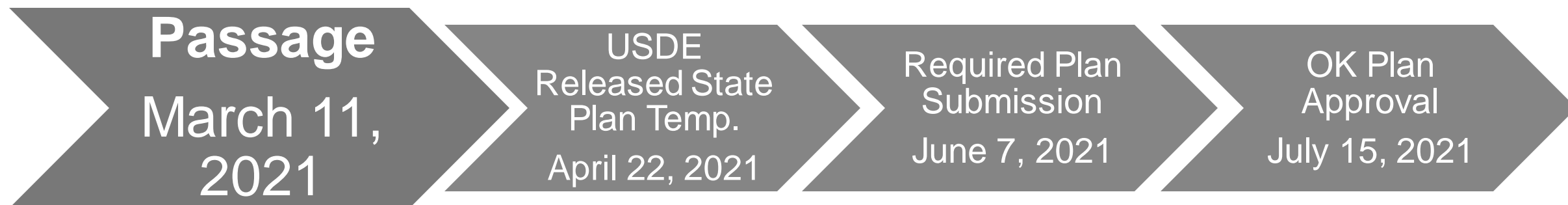

- Plans must be reviewed and approved OSDE

Data Reporting Requirements

- U.S. Department of Education data collection tool released for public comment July 2 – August 31, 2021
- U.S. Department of Education revised data collection tool released for public comment October 26 – November 29, 2021
- Funds are provided on reimbursement basis.
- Districts will report use of funds through the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System.



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
