#### To Whom It May Concern:

Billings Public School, district 52i002, is requesting special permission to make claims on our 2016-2017 federal funds even though it is past the normal deadline: funds are for project 511 (Title I), 541 (Title II), 621 (Special Education flow through), and 641 (Special Education preschool). These funds were allocated to the district and the district spent the money for the approved purposes, but the district failed to file the claims to actually draw down the money. There was some confusion that caused this problem including a new person in that position and the district switching to new accounting software at the same time (i.e. the new person didn't know how to use the old system which was needed in order to process the claims). In hindsight, as the superintendent I should have made sure all of this was taken care of in a timely manner; however, I failed to do so and now need to apologize for my oversight and humbly ask for an exception to fix the problem.

Normally, having carryover funds doesn't cause a major problem; the district could merely spend the money the next year. However, since the funds in question are special education and Title dollars, the district will face a future problem when "maintenance of effort" is calculated. Basically, it will appear that the district spent additional local dollars in 2016-2017 (since the federal money would not have been spent) and much less local dollars in 2017-2018 (since there would be extra federal money to spend); thus, when "maintenance of effort" is calculated, the district will lose significant federal dollars in 2018-2019 if this exception is not granted. I am making this request in order for the district not to be harmed financially in the future.
