## CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Superintendent Barresi called the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Commission meeting to order at 1:08 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting. Ms. Cheadle called the roll and ascertained there was a quorum.

#### SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

Superintendent Barresi thanked the Commission's participation at February's meeting.

# PRESENTATION ON STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH FOR TEACHERS AND LEADERS OF NON-TESTED GRADES AND SUBJECTS

Dr. Kerri White presented information shared at the Working Group #2 workshop. Participants included teachers and administrators of non-tested grades and subjects, and their feedback. Dr. White reviewed the final student academic group recommendations that included new information available from other states, school districts and experts, information not available at the last workshop meeting in the spring of 2013; three options presented to the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Commission (TLE) and needed help to plan for next steps of implementation of the recommendation; TLE historical timeline, various state comparisons/feedback, value-added comparisons, Working Group #2 recommendation reconsideration/modification; and student learning (SLO) and student outcome objectives (SOO), process, and structure.

Commission members discussed evaluation fairness to large, middle, and small school districts, available and consistent assessment options, district benchmarks, assessment state banks, professional development and technical assistance, SLO/SOO improvements and implementation, Oklahoma recommended options/costs, and OMES assistance.

# RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION REGARDING THE STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH FOR NON-TESTED GRADES AND SUBJECTS

Dr. White presented draft recommendation #23 for the Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) to adopt a student learning objective/student outcome objective (SLO/SOO) structure for the student academic growth component of the TLE for teachers and leaders of ontested grades and subjects; #24 to require districts to develop student academic growth policies and; #25 continue to convene working group of stakeholders, including teachers and administrators of non-tested grades, and subjects to develop recommended practices for a variety of content areas and teacher/leader types.

Recommendations 23, 24, and 25 are guidelines of support and suggestions; they are not requirements. These guidelines, upon the Commission's recommendation, will be presented to the State Board of Education for adoption.

Alicia Priest said she would provide the states that have pulled away from SOOs and SLOs in response to Senator Shumate's question.
