## **Targeted Intervention Schools Guide**

Oklahoma's ESEA flexibility waiver specifies that Oklahoma will annually identify the lowestperforming schools in Oklahoma that are not already identified as Priority or Focus schools as "Targeted Intervention" schools.

Schools will be identified as a Targeted Intervention school if they meet any of the following criteria:

- 1. The school receives an overall grade of 'D-', 'D', or 'D+' on the <u>A F Report Card</u>.
- 2. The school has a graduation rate below 60.0% in the most recently reported school year (High Schools only).

Additionally, the school must not already be identified as a Priority or Focus school in the current school year.
