

Targeted Intervention Schools Guide

Oklahoma's ESEA flexibility waiver specifies that Oklahoma will annually identify the lowest-performing schools in Oklahoma that are not already identified as Priority or Focus schools as "Targeted Intervention" schools.

Schools will be identified as a Targeted Intervention school if they meet any of the following criteria:

1. The school receives an overall grade of 'D-', 'D', or 'D+' on the [A – F Report Card](#).
2. The school has a graduation rate below 60.0% in the most recently reported school year (High Schools only).

Additionally, the school must not already be identified as a Priority or Focus school in the current school year.
