

Targeted Intervention Schools Guide

Oklahoma's ESEA flexibility waiver specifies that Oklahoma will identify schools with under-performing graduation rates that are not already identified as Priority or Focus schools as "Targeted Intervention" schools.

Schools will be identified as a Targeted Intervention school if the graduation rate for at least one of the ESEA subgroups below is lower than the most recently reported national average for that subgroup.

Students with Disabilities (IEP)
English Language Learners
Black or African American
