



Tips for Teaching Expected Behaviors

Where to Start?	
Start by selecting one to three expectations where you see the opportunity for growth.	Model the behavior in the location where you want to see it.
Give clear, specific directions.	Teach the wanted behavior one step at a time.
Show examples and non-examples of the behavior.	Give direct, positive feedback.

Ways to Demonstrate Desired Behavior	
Role Play	Demonstration Posters or Visuals
Songs, Poems	Picture Books, Social Stories
Flash Cards	Learning Games and Videos

Other Useful Ideas	
Be patient! It takes time to learn a new procedure.	Be consistent!
Provide acknowledgement of desired behavior.	Give 5 positive praises to one behavior correction. (5:1 Positive Praise Rule)
Use logical consequences.	Learning Games and Videos
