U.S. History Assessment Update

School districts needing to assess seniors in U.S. History have two options. Districts can use these same **two options** for any students who are currently in U.S. History, or they can choose to wait until next year's field test to assess these students.

Option 1 is to participate in the U.S. History Formative Assessment Study. We are currently developing a few formative assessment options that districts can choose from. The Formative Assessment Study tasks will be available to schools in late March and will not be tied to the testing window. Schools will choose from the available options, taking approximately two class periods. Schools will report student participation (not scores) to the state.

Option 2 is to administer a summative, multiple-choice assessment to students. This assessment is now available to schools on the Wave. This assessment will not be tied to the testing window and will be available throughout the school year. Information regarding reporting participation (not scores) to the state will be forthcoming at a later date.
