OVERVIEW

The Oklahoma State Department of Education (SDE) is seeking science educators and stakeholders to participate in the science item writing process. The SDE, in collaboration with its testing vendor, will be holding an item writing workshop to author new assessment items for the Oklahoma Core Curriculum Tests in Science Grades 5, 8, and Biology. The new items will be aligned to the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Science (OASS).

The goal of the science item writing workshop is to generate assessment items that will be further reviewed by the testing vendor, SDE, and educator committees and then be field-tested for use in future Science OCCTs.

Educators and stakeholders who are currently teaching/working at Grades 5, 8, and High School Biology are invited to apply. Individuals will be selected through the process defined in this application to participate in the item writing workshop.

TIMELINE FOR SEQUENCE OF WORK

The item writing workshop will require three days to complete. Applicants must be able to commit to all three days In order to be considered for the item review committee. The item writing workshop session will take place Thursday, August 27, through Saturday, August 29, 2015. <u>Teachers are required to bring their own laptop to this session.</u>

TRAVEL, ACCOMMODATIONS, FINANCIAL REIMBURSEMENT AND MEALS

Oklahoma educators that are selected through this application process will be provided with travel reimbursement, lodging, and meals for the workshop. Additionally, an honorarium of \$200 will be paid for participation on district noncontract days. If a substitute teacher is required in your absence, your school will be reimbursed for the cost of the substitute up to 100 dollars for Thursday and/or Friday.
