



Revocation of Consent for Special Education and Related Services

Pursuant to 34 C.F.R. § 300.300(b)(4), I hereby revoke consent for my child listed above, to receive special education and related services in order to accept the Lindsey Nicole Henry (LNH) Scholarship. I understand that if I wish for special education and related services to be provided to my child at any time in the future, I must request a new evaluation under C.F.R. § 300.300(a), and that special education services will only be available to my child upon completion of a new evaluation and a determination that my child is eligible for services under the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act* (IDEA).

NOTIFICATION TO SCHOOL DISTRICT

The student identified above has agreed to accept the LNH Scholarship. Accepting the LNH Scholarship will have the same effect as revocation of consent for special education services. When a parent chooses to revoke consent, the revocation is in its entirety. Acceptance of the LNH Scholarship will forfeit all special education services, related services and any other special education supports, including the child's IEP developed while the child was enrolled in the public school district. When the parent revokes consent by accepting the LNH Scholarship, the school district:

- Is not in violation of the requirement to make available a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) to the child for its failure to provide services to the child;
- Will treat the child as a non-disabled student for disciplinary purposes in the public school setting if the child returns to the public school environment; and
- Is not required to amend the child's education records to remove any reference to the child's receipt of special education and related services.

The next step for the district is to respond to the parent's revocation with a written notice regarding the termination of the educational placement and special education and related services that will result from the revocation of consent. The district will document "parent revocation of services" as a non-eligibility event in OK EdPlan and then proceed with making the student inactive in OK EdPlan with the exit reason, "Accepting the LNH Scholarship." If the parent elects to re-enroll the child in a public school, terminating eligibility for the LNH Scholarship, the parent or legal guardian or the school district may initiate a request for an initial evaluation to determine if the child is eligible for services under the IDEA.
