



LEA Procedures p.12	SeeWorth ended the partnership with Eagle Ridge due to the discovery of inappropriate content in their curriculum. Vendor for 2011-2012 was changed to 21 Days to Change. External provider for counseling was dropped in the 2012-2013 school year.
LEA Budget Narrative p. 51-52	<p>SeeWorth added 1.5 additional counselors to support student performance.</p> <p>SeeWorth added .4 curriculum specialists to work with instructional staff to align curriculum, modify curriculum based on Benchmark data, observe classroom to insure curriculum implementation, develop and/or modify lesson plans based on student levels and Benchmark data, provide instructor support on curriculum content, work with Transformation Officer on PD related to curriculum development and alignment.</p> <p>SeeWorth added 1.6 supplemental reading teachers and 1 supplemental math teacher to support remediation.</p> <p>SeeWorth student demographic data reflects a growing Hispanic student population. Many of those students are English language learners. To address the specific needs of these students, the LEA hired 1 ELL teacher to identify and support ELL students.</p> <p>SeeWorth will use SuccessMaker licenses to provide web based curriculum and test prep to be used in supplemental reading and math in the elementary and middle schools.</p> <p>SeeWorth dropped the Data Coordinator position from SIG funding. The position is now funded through general funds.</p>

The LEA would like to set new SMART goals for the 2012-2013 school year to focus efforts on increasing student proficiency in Math and Language Arts.</p> <p>SMART Language Arts Goal: 60% of all FAY students passing regular or modified state CRT and EOI reading and writing assessments. SMART Mathematics Goal: 60% of all FAY students passing regular or modified CRT and EOI Math assessments. SMART graduation goals will remain the same.</p>
