The last school year adult meals were coded to 1730 and a la carte (extra milk, 2nd entrées, bottled water, pizza, snack items which meet Smart Snack requirements) was coded 1720. Some parents who prepaid last year and the students selected a la carte food items did not get moved from 1710 (Students meals) to 1720 (a la carte), but funds were transferred into the SFA's nonprofit school food service account. Corrective Action Required: Ensure a la carte food items expenses are coded to the OCAS account code 3110 and a la carte revenue is coded to the OCAS code 1720. Ensure all nonprogram revenues and costs are used in the calculations to ensure compliance with the Revenue from No program Food requirements. Food Safety, Storage and Buy American Requirement: 1402. A review of products indicates violations of the Buy American provision in 7 CFR 210.21(d). Findings: Food items identified as not meeting the Buy American requirements. Corrective Action Required: Include the Buy American in all solicitations for products to include the requirement of Buy Ameri |
