- Launched in 2014-15 at Union High School and Union Alternative School
- Designed to expose students to high-demand career opportunities during the school day through industrybased coursework and "on the job" opportunities
- Utilizes a "learn and earn" philosophy; some companies offer paid internships during the second semester and full time employment upon graduation
- Students earn nationally-recognized certifications, such as WorkKeys, Manufacturing (Manufacturing, Quality, Safety, & Maintenance), OSHA, Child Development Associate, and Ford/Fleet automotive certifications.

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High school students attend classes in industry-based settings and earn nationally-recognized certifications prior to graduation.
