The final round of revisions are complete! 79 reviews were submitted during the first public comment period for the draft Oklahoma Academic Standards for Computer Science (OAS-CS). Along with the careful review of the Draft Review Team, comprised of 25 Oklahoma educators from K-12, Career Tech, and collegiate levels, the final public draft offers what we believe to be a benchmark from which other state standards will be judged.

Today launches our final public comment period that will conclude on February 22, 2018, with the submission of these proposed standards to the Oklahoma State Board of Education for their review and consideration.

We ask that all interested stakeholders take time to review the proposed standards and to provide their comments to Levi Patrick, Assistant Executive Director of Curriculum and Instruction, at Levi.Patrick@sde.ok.gov with the subject line: *OAS-CS Final Draft Feedback*. Feedback should be provided **before February 22, 2018** in order to be presented at the Oklahoma State Board of Education public meeting. Other public comments are welcome that day in person.
