Bishop Kelley is an accredited high school for grades 9-12 in the Diocese of Tulsa. Currently students with diagnosed disabilities receive limited accommodations but do not receive modifications to the curriculum. Accommodations most frequently used are extended time for testing, tests read orally, change of setting for testing, dictation of essay questions, use of word processor in the classroom, enlarged print text books, enlarged font for notes and tests, accommodated classroom seating, and use of resource room to work on assignments.
